

THE BOARD OF COOPERATIVE EDUCATIONAL SERVICES

The Board of Cooperative Educational Services, Rensselaer-Columbia-Greene Counties, otherwise known as Questar III, is a body corporate established according to the Laws of New York State and has the powers and duties set forth under law. Questar III is governed by a Board of Education composed as provided by law. Its members are considered local officials when they perform their duties regarding educational matters, as set forth in the New York State Constitution and the Education Law of New York State. The Board shall be composed of eleven members who shall be elected by resolution of the component boards as provided by section 1950 of the Education Law. The term of office of Board members shall be three (3) years. Board members shall be residents of a component district. Unless otherwise provided by law, board members shall each be residents of different component school districts. Upon formation of the Board of Cooperative Educational Services, Rensselaer-Columbia-Greene Counties, it was agreed that representation on the board be apportioned among the component school districts of the counties as follows: five members from Rensselaer County, four members from Columbia County and two members from Greene County.
