# What is STAC

- STAC = The System to Track and Account for Children
  - The STAC Online System (EFRT) is used to submit requests for aid reimbursement, view payments and program information
- STAC is the only way to claim excess high-cost aid
- No STAC = No Aid



# Why is it Important?

### **BUSINESS OFFICE**

- One of the largest expensedriven aids for a school district
- Budgeting and planning implications
  - Projections
  - Long-Term Planning
  - Basic Contribution Chargebacks
- Understand how and when State Aid will flow
- Can only be captured through the NYSED STAC online system (EFRT)

### **SPECIAL EDUCATION**


- One of the district's largest budgeting expenses
- Rigorous state regulations for special education and excess cost aid may not align
- Form A Additional State Aid weighting for students with disabilities
- Provides additional funding to support programs and services for students with disabilities

# **Communication is Key**

Working together for the betterment of students

- Meetings between the CSE Office and Business Office are key to maximizing Excess Cost Aid
  - Current status of your STACs
    - Current year input (24-25) & Verifying (23-24)
    - Have all costs been captured?
    - Any expenditures funded from a Federal grant?
    - Is the methodology reasonable?
    - Have your Eligible Homeless Youth been captured in STAC?
    - Understand your grade levels and programming for budgeting purposes
- Are you on track and timely for Aid to flow?
  - Were all ESY placements and students be accounted for and verified by mid-February 2025?
  - Were your 2023-24 Homeless verified?

### **Private Placements**

#### **Definition:**

Private Excess Cost Aid payable for students with disabilities placed in **approved** in-state and out-of-state private schools

Day and Residential, Rome and Batavia, Special Act Union Free School Districts

#### Formula:

(SED Approved Tuition Rate - Basic Contribution) x Aid Ratio x FTE

#### Aid Claim Process & Facts:

- Education Rates set by NYS Education Department's Rate Setting Unit
- Maintenance Rates set by NYS Office of Children & Family Services
- Aid is paid the year following students' enrollment (up to 25% in December (approved costs), additional 45% in March (approved costs), additional 15% in June (approved costs), additional 15% in August (verified costs), remaining balance if any in September (verified costs)
- County Social Services pays provider for 10-month maintenance costs and then bills the school district of residence 56.848% of maintenance costs

#### **Statute of Limitations:**

Two years - (one year for 'current year' aid)



# Private Placement (DCERTs)

- Required for all 10-month private placements on an annual basis:
  - Day In-State / Day Out-of-State
  - Residential In-State / Residential Out-of-State
- Required for the following instances:
  - Change in placement type
    - Day / Residential
    - In-State / Out-of-State
  - Change in CSE
  - Change from preschool to school age

- Districts must submit Out-of-State application packet annually to NYSED Non-District Unit for approval
- This approval process is for State Aid reimbursement purposes, not 'placement approval'
- In order to receive aid, the Out-of-State placement must be on the NYSED approval list

Annual program cost - (3 x AOE/TAPU) x Aid Ratio x FTE

Aid is paid year following students' enrollment (up to 25% in December (approved costs), additional 45% in March (approved costs), additional 15% in June (approved costs), additional 15% in August (verified costs), remaining balance if any in September (verified costs)

# **Aidable Homeless Placements**

**Nonresident** homeless students from another district in NYS who have designated your district as their educating district. Applies to all students

#### Formula:

Aid is paid at 100% of approved tuition cost (based on NRT rate or out of district program costs)

#### Aid Claim Process & Facts:

- No ESY Homeless STACs
- Aid is paid year following students' enrollment
- Transportation costs are eligible for Transportation Aid
- District of origin is responsible for the basic contribution which is deducted from state aid
  - Last residence before the student became homeless

#### **Statute of Limitations:**

One Year- 2023-24 Homeless need to be verified by June 30<sup>th</sup> 2025

- The student will be living in Temporary Housing



- Encouraged to send a copy of STAC 202 to the district that is fiscally responsible
  - Treat them as you would like to be treated
- Verify all children the district is being charged for, were actual district residents (are these truly your students?)
  - DQCDI Report
- Follow up on your homeless children being charged against you
  - When obtain permanent housing?
  - Inform the Business Office of status
    - Budgeting implications

# **CPSE** Administrative Costs



Section 4410 of NYS Education Law authorizes school districts to receive reimbursement from counties for reasonable and necessary CPSE administrative costs incurred for preschool students



Districts record administrative expenses in the State Aid Management System (SAMS) (via Schedules 31-34 of their district ST-3 form) for a given school year



The STAC and Medicaid Unit extracts this information from the SAMS system and uploads to STAC



School districts can view their CPSE Administrative Cost Listing (ACL) via the **DQDAT** STAC online screen



School districts must voucher their respective counties to receive reimbursement for CPSE administrative costs
