# What is STAC

- STAC = The System to Track and Account for Children
  - The STAC Online System (EFRT) is used to submit requests for aid reimbursement, view payments and program information
- STAC is the only way to claim excess high-cost aid
- No STAC = No Aid



# Why is it Important?

#### **BUSINESS OFFICE**

- One of your top State Aid generating categories
- Budgeting and planning implications
  - Projections
  - Long-Term Planning
  - Basic Contribution Chargebacks
- Understand how and when State Aid will flow
- Can only be captured through the NYSED STAC online system (EFRT)

#### **SPECIAL EDUCATION**

- One of the district's largest budgeting expenses for SPED programming and placements
- Rigorous state regulations and changes
- Additional State Aid on student weighting for classified students
- Provides additional funding to support students with disabilities programs

# **Communication is Key**

Working together for the betterment of students

- Meetings between the CSE Office and Business Office are key to maximizing Excess Cost Aid
  - Current status of your STACs
    - Current year input (23-24) & Verifying (22-23)
    - Have all costs been captured?
    - Any expenditures funded from a Federal grant?
    - Is the methodology reasonable?
    - Have your Homeless Youth been captured in STAC?
    - Understand your grade levels and programming for budgeting purposes
- Are you on track and timely?
  - Will all ESY placements and students be accounted for and verified by mid-February 2024?



In-District, BOCES, Other Public School District

### **Public Placements**

#### **Definition:**

Aid for resident students with disabilities served in a public school or BOCES program, for whom the annualized cost exceeds 3 times the district's AOE/TAPU (PUB output report – line 5)

#### Formula:

Annual program cost - (3 x AOE/TAPU) x Aid Ratio x FTE

#### Aid Claim Process & Facts:

Aid is paid year following students' enrollment (up to 25% in December (approved costs), additional 45% in March (approved costs), additional 15% in June (approved costs), additional 15% in August (verified costs), remaining balance if any in September (verified costs)

#### **Statute of Limitations:**

Two years – (one year for 'current year' aid)

  - Self-contained classrooms
    - Low enrollment

# Summary

- STAC based on student specific IEP information
- Always use the annualized cost to STAC (As if the student received the services for the full year)
- The student FTE will calculate within the STAC system based on enrollment dates
- Common misconception; not STACing students who do not attend full year/program because they do not meet the district threshold
- Avoid paying staff that work with your high cost students out of your 611/619 Federal Grant

## **BOCES Placements**

#### Doing Together What Cannot Be Done Alone!



- STAC the total annualized cost for the BOCES placement
- Services provided to the student by a third party can be added to the STAC
- Always verify with the Year-End Summary report provided by each BOCES (usually comes out between November and February of the following year)

#### Nonresident Tuition Rates

- Special Education K-6
- Special Education 7-12
- Final NRT rates for the 2022-23 school year will come out in December 2023
- Add any cost of services provided by the CSE district or contracted provider

#### Actual Cost

- The educating district must provide a cost breakdown of services provided to the student
- Add any cost of services provided by the CSE district or contracted provider

## **Homeless Placements**

#### **Definition:**

Only **nonresident** homeless students from another district in NYS who have designated your district as their educating district are eligible for state aid reimbursement through the STAC online system. Applies to regular education students or students with disabilities

#### Formula:

Aid is paid at 100% of approved tuition cost (based on NRT rate or out of district program costs)

#### Aid Claim Process & Facts:

- No ESY Homeless STACs
- Aid is paid year following students' enrollment
- Transportation costs are reported on the ST-3
- District of origin is responsible for the basic contribution which is deducted from state aid
  - Last residence before the student became homeless

#### **Statute of Limitations:**

One Year- 2022-23 Homeless need to be verified by June 30th 2024

## STAC 202 Form

#### STAC-202

- SED only uses the STAC-202 forms for reimbursement purposes each year
  - School districts use the STAC-202 form to collect data on students who have been identified as homeless. Completed STAC forms help districts report on such things as the number of students who are homeless in the school district



  - Contact designated district of attendance to correct information
  - Chargeback detail student posted by STAC Unit (DQCDI)
  - FTE chargeback totals posted on State Aid GEN Report
  - Districts should regularly review designation forms received, eligibility records on DQHOM, and chargebacks posted by STAC Unit

### **Homeless Best Practices**

- Encouraged to send a copy of STAC 202 to the district that is fiscally responsible
  - Treat them as you would like to be treated
- Verify all children the district is being charged for, were actual district residents (are these truly your students?)
  - DQCDI Report
- Follow up on your homeless children being charged against you
  - When obtain permanent housing?
  - Inform the Business Office of status
    - Budgeting implications







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#### Common Losses

## **Reporting Annualized Costs**

Misunderstanding on how to report costs for partial year attendance in the program

- Report the Annualized Cost of the Program
- SED will pro-rate for FTE
- Example: If billed \$10,000 for 1 month, the Annualized Cost is \$100,000 (\$10,000 x 10 months)

## In-District High Cost

- Calculation of in-district programs not including all eligible costs or are miscalculated
- Are you including:
  - The salaries and fringes (medical, dental, FICA, ERS/TRS, etc.) of all staff in the classroom?
    - Does the cost per class/session seem reasonable?
  - Cost of related services both in-district staff and contractual services?
  - Was any specialized equipment purchased for a child?
  - Dividing costs of the classroom by actual student count vs. classroom ratio?
- Recommend you talk through the methodology with the person doing the calculations
- Salaries and fringes are paid from grant funds

## Summer School (ESY)

- 72
- Calculation of district operated transportation not including all eligible expenses.
  - When was the last time the base bus cost per mile was calculated?
- Supplemental Schedules for district operated program are not being completed accurately or at all
  - Ensure both offices are working together to claim all eligible expenses for district operated program (staffing, enrollment, etc.)

## **CPSE** Administrative Costs

- Section 4410 of NYS Education Law authorizes school districts to receive reimbursement from counties for reasonable and necessary CPSE administrative costs incurred for preschool students
- Districts record administrative expenses in the State Aid Management System (SAMS) (via Schedules 31-34 of their district ST-3 form) for a given school year
- The STAC and Medicaid Unit extracts this information from the SAMS system and uploads to STAC
- School districts can view their CPSE Administrative Cost Listing (ACL) via the DQDAT STAC online screen
- School districts must continue to voucher their respective counties to receive reimbursement for CPSE administrative costs


