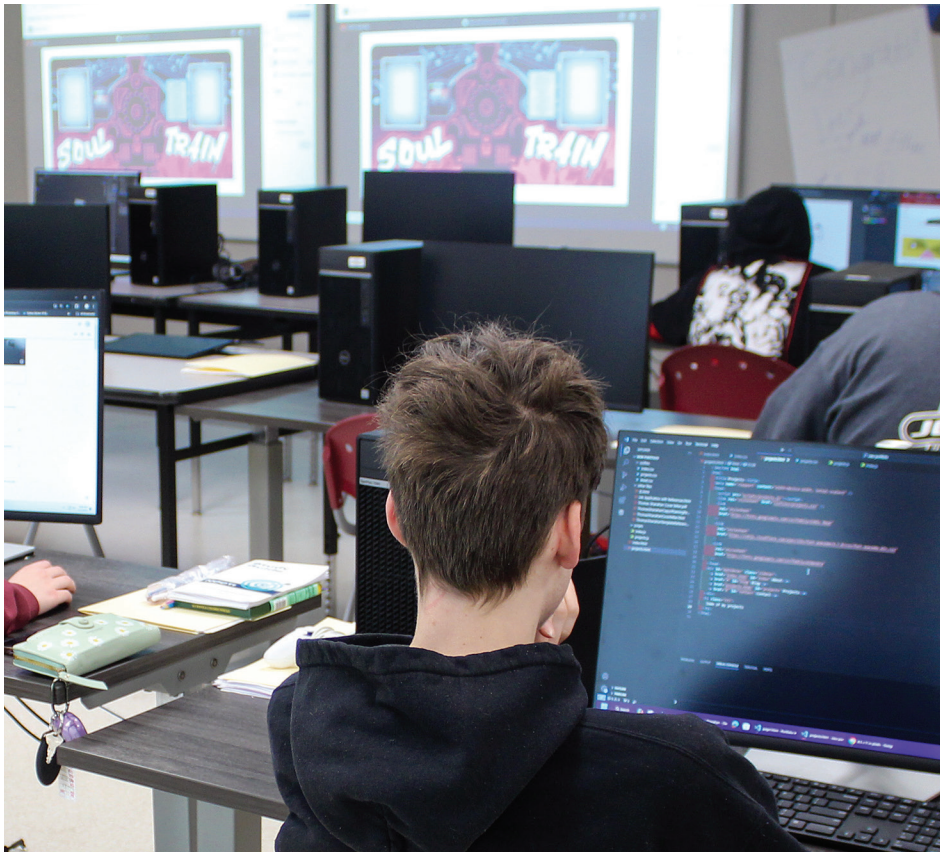


GAMING & MULTIMEDIA
