The program — offered in partnership with St. Peter's Health Partners, Russell Sage College and Hudson Valley Community College (HVCC) — is based at Samaritan Hospital in Troy. It features an integrated curriculum that includes college coursework in English Language Arts, and Anatomy and Physiology while meeting NYS 12th grade course requirements in English and Social Studies. Students spend over 80 hours shadowing in clinical settings.
